The Venus Flytrap is a plant that traps and eats insects. It belongs to a group
of (23) plants. This group also includes sundews and pitcher
plants.
The Venus Flytrap is a small plant with leaves that have toothed edges and
hairs on top which are sensitive to touch. The leaf releases sweet nectar that
(24) flies and other insects.
When an insect crawls between the two halves of a leaf, the hairs detect its
presence. In less than a second, the leaf snaps shut and the toothed edges lock
together. Once the insect is (25), the leaf releases digestive
juices. This is the start of the digestive process. The leaf absorbs the
(26) from the insect and transports them to all parts of the plant.
This ensures that the plant grows well.
