

The insect world includes thousands of different types of dragonflies. They come in a variety of colours like red, blue, and green. Some of them have spots or stripes on their wings. Darting through the garden, they may not look like fierce hunters, but they are. Studies show that they are one of the most deadly hunters on Earth.

Dragonflies feed on smaller insects such as moths, flies, and mosquitoes. They grab their prey with their feet while in flight. This means they need to be swift. In fact, these acrobats rank as the fastest of all flying insects. A dragonfly in hot pursuit of a meal can fly as fast as up to 56 kilometres per hour and they are able to catch most of the prey that they target.

The dragonfly's skills include more than speed. Their eyes are made of thousands of tiny lenses that take up most of the space on their heads. These lenses give them super sight. Their ability to sense motion and detect movement in almost all directions is because their eyes and brains are naturally tuned to be able for them to do so. Therefore, dragonflies can see a meal coming from almost any direction. The only blind spot for an insect to hide is right behind a dragonfly. This insect hunter has a big appetite. One dragonfly eats up to a hundred mosquitoes in a day and this makes them a welcome garden guest. Due to their great appetite and swift speed, dragonflies wolf down their meals while still in flight!


