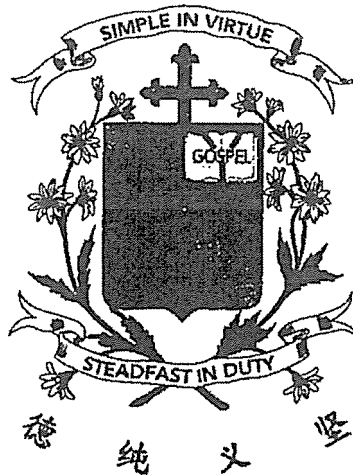

Maggots are worm-like creatures that live in decaying food or flesh. They can be used to clean wounds so that they heal faster. It was reported that maggots have been used as a wound treatment since a long time ago by some tribes. During World War I, doctors also noticed that soldiers with maggot-infested gashes did not get the expected infections or swelling seen in other patients.

In maggot therapy, the maggots are typically placed in small, porous packages and applied to the wound. The small maggots will then eat up dead tissue. They do this far more precisely than in normal operation and can clean a wound in a day or two. However, the maggot therapy is not suitable for all wounds. Wounds that are dry do not provide a good environment for maggots to feed on.

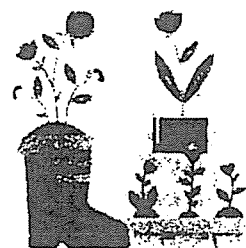

Josh just shrugged. "But Daisy, Christmas is all about miracles!"

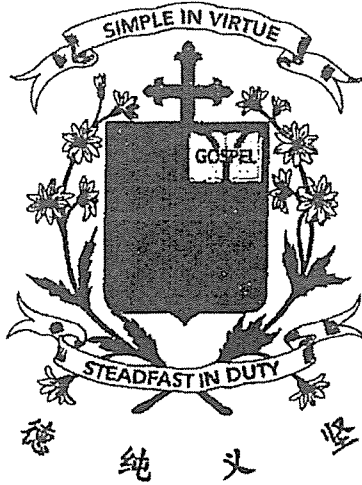
I was about to argue that we would need one just to keep our house. However, I swallowed my words.
